

RESPIRALIA 2010

“II CHARITY ULTRA MARATHON AGAINST CYSTIC FIBROSIS”

Article 1: The Respiralia Foundation and the Cystic Fibrosis Association of the Balearics organize the II Charity Ultra Marathon against Cystic Fibrosis on **Sunday September 26, 2010.**

Article 2: All the people, being federated or not, will be able to participate at the II Charity Ultra Marathon against Cystic Fibrosis. This is an 80 km urban race by foot on a 5 km asphalt circuit at the Paseo Marítimo in Palma de Mallorca, where all the kilometric points will be indicated.

Article 3: The Start will be at 10 a. m. and the challenge will finish at 5 p. m., being this the latest hour for runners to reach the finish line. The Start and Finish line will be set at the Camí de S'Escollera (in front of the Cathedral of Palma).

This is a solidary non-profit race, where all the incomes will be fully dedicated to finance the treatments that receive the Children with Cystic Fibrosis through the Respiralia Foundation and the Cystic Fibrosis Association of the Balearics.

The race will be organized by teams and by relays, being its objective that every team completes 80 kilometers, with no competitive purpose, in a maximum of 7 hours.

Teams may consist of a number between 1 and 16 runners. At the end of the challenge, all the kilometers run by the members of a team will be added to get the total distance run by this team.

The runners of a team may run at a time or by relays, but they will respect that the last one will arrive no later than 5 p. m. Distance and time will be controlled by a chip that will carry every runner.

At 5 p. m. the race will be over and the chip control will be closed.

The Organization team will be able to set the number of runners of the same team that will run at the same time, depending on the mark they have at the Athletics Federation's register. If they are not federated, a mark of 10 minutes per kilometer will be supposed to set the number of runners of each relay to avoid that this team overtakes 7 hours when running the 80 kilometers of the challenge.

Runners will have a stand to leave their belongings at the Start/Finish area, as well as some chemical W. C. and a stand with solid food and liquids in the same area.

Article 4: The inscriptions will be available via internet from the 6th to the 25th of September, both included, through www.elitechip.net with the Championship system. Once the distance to run is chosen, the runner will pay the inscription fee via bank transfer to the bank account of Bancaja **2077 0863 44 3100284058**, property of the Cystic Fibrosis Association of the Balearics.

The inscription will be formalized when the Organization receives the transfer receipt via email (fundacio@respiralia.org) or at the Respiralia Foundation & Cystic Fibrosis Association of the Balearics headquarters (C/ Dinamarca, 9 - 07015 - Palma).

PRICES DEPENDING ON THE DISTANCE TO RUN (people with cystic fibrosis, for free):

- 5 Km: 10,00 €
- 10 or 15 Km: 15,00 €
- 20, 25 or 30 Km: 20,00 €
- 40 or 50 Km: 25,00 €
- 60, 70 or 80 Km: 30,00 €

Article 5: 50% of the inscription fee will be returned only when the runner shows a medical certificate at the Respiralia Foundation headquarters (C/ Dinamarca, 9 in Palma) where it is said that an illness or injury impeded the runner to participate in the event.

Article 6: As it is a non-competitive challenge, it won't be any prize for classification, run distance, etc. It will only be established the I Tolo Calafat Prize to the person with Cystic Fibrosis that runs the longest distance and to the youngest and to the oldest runner.

Article 7: Dorsal numbers and chips will be delivered only and exclusively at the Championship stand from 8:30 of the day of the challenge. To take the dorsal number and the chip it will be necessary to show the

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DNI or passport. All the runners that are going to start de race at 10 a. m. will take the chip and dorsal number no later than 9:30.

The race will be timed by the Championship-Elitechip system

There will be time controls along the circuit. Only the participants carrying the chip provided by the Organization will appear at the runners list. The chip can be the one provided by Elitechip or a particular one. In this last case, the code must appear at the inscription form and it must belong to the Elitechip system. The runner should always check the proper functioning of his/her chip at the Elitechip stand set at the Start area.

The Organization will have the right to close the inscription period when it is considered necessary.

Article 8: Dorsal numbers are personal and nontransferable. They must be positioned on the chest without any manipulation or bending. Control chip is personal and nontransferable as well and it will be placed on the shoelaces. The runner who doesn't follow this rule will have to leave the circuit. The Organization will have the right to expel from the race to the runner who manipulates and/or cedes the dorsal number to another runner, alters the data given to the Organization regarding the Identity Card data or the federative form, doesn't finish the circuit, not completing the circuit, exhibits a bad physical condition, doesn't facilitate the documentation required by the Organization or breaches any other rule of the Athletics Federation. Runners not inscribed or the ones who run without any dorsal number or chip will not be allowed to run in this challenge.

Also, the Organization, the Local Police or the Port Police will be able to expel any runner who breaches any rule.

Article 9: The circuit will be properly indicated by the Organization. As it is a closed circuit, relatively short, it will be a stand with solid and liquid food, coinciding with the Finish area. Runners will be able to leave its own food in this stand.

Article 10: Health services and ambulances will be coordinated by the medical team and will be set close to the Start area (Camí de S'Escollera).

All runners will fill the rear part of the dorsal number with their name, surnames, telephone number in case of emergency, any medical problem (allergies, special attentions required, etc.) if necessary or any specific treatment they need and their blood group.

Article 11: It won't be allowed the access to the circuit with bicycles or any motorized vehicle.

Article 12: All runners, when sending the inscription form, declare knowing and accepting this Rules and the Statement of Disclaimer and Privacy. In case of doubt, the Organization's criteria will prevail

Statement of Disclaimer and Privacy.

By simply registering, the runner declares: “I am in a healthy state, optimum to participate at the II Charity Ultra Marathon against Cystic Fibrosis. In addition, I release from any responsibility to the Organization, sponsors or other involved institutions if any accident or injure may occur before, during and/or after the sport event, resigning from this moment to any legal action against any mentioned entities. During the development of the event I will collaborate as much as possible with the Organization to avoid personal accidents. I also authorize to the Organization to use any picture, video or any other audiovisual material where I may appear for publicity purposes, accepting the publishing of my name at the participants list of the challenge, at the media and/or internet, without expecting any payment, compensation or reward for this matter.

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Article 14: By simply registering at the II Charity Ultra Marathon against Cystic Fibrosis, participants give their consent to the Respiralia Foundation and to the Cystic Fibrosis Association of the Balearics to manage automatically, by themselves or through third parties, and with an exclusively sportive, promotional or commercial goal, his/her personal data.

According to what it is stated in the Organic Law 15/1999, of December 13, about the Personal Data Privacy, the runner has the right to access these files in order to amend or cancel totally or partially its content. To do this, he/she must apply in writing to the Respiralia Foundation and Cystic Fibrosis Association of the Balearics headquarters in C/ Dinamarca, 9 (07015 – Palma de Mallorca).

The Organization reserves the right to make any change in these Rules if it deems appropriate and shall inform about it on its website www.respiralia.org and to the registered participants.
